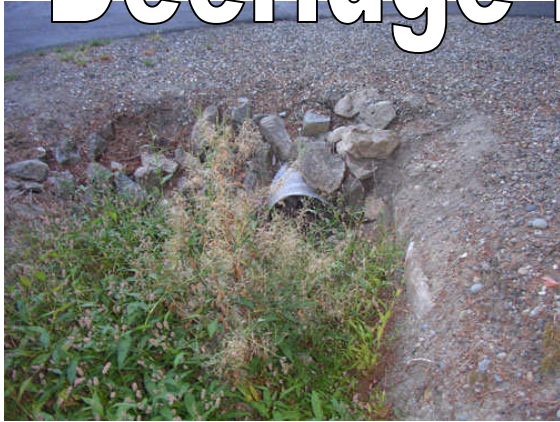


Deeridge Escapement Drain



After some unauthorized construction over a county maintained drainage system in the early 90's the system became silted and eventually plugged with weeds and mud.



This drain carries excess rainwater from a clay apron under lots 24, 25 and 26 and enters the system at a drain located on the east side of Deeridge in front of lot 23. The water is carried under Deeridge through a pipe to the west side in front of lot 4.



The rainwater is delivered to the "detention" pond #56 located on the west side of Deeridge between lots 4 and 5 via the cleaned out channel. The detention pond is sculpted and fenced to hold large amounts of rainwater until it evaporates or absorbed.



This system is maintained by Kitsap County and funded by residents of Ridgecrest on their annual county tax statement, therefore Ridgecrest residents will directly pay any damage.
